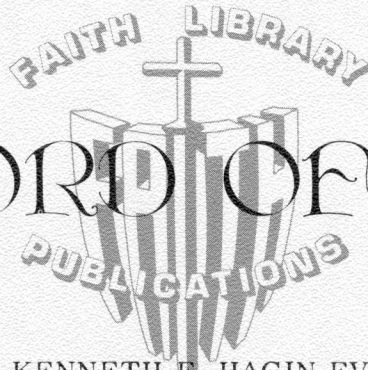

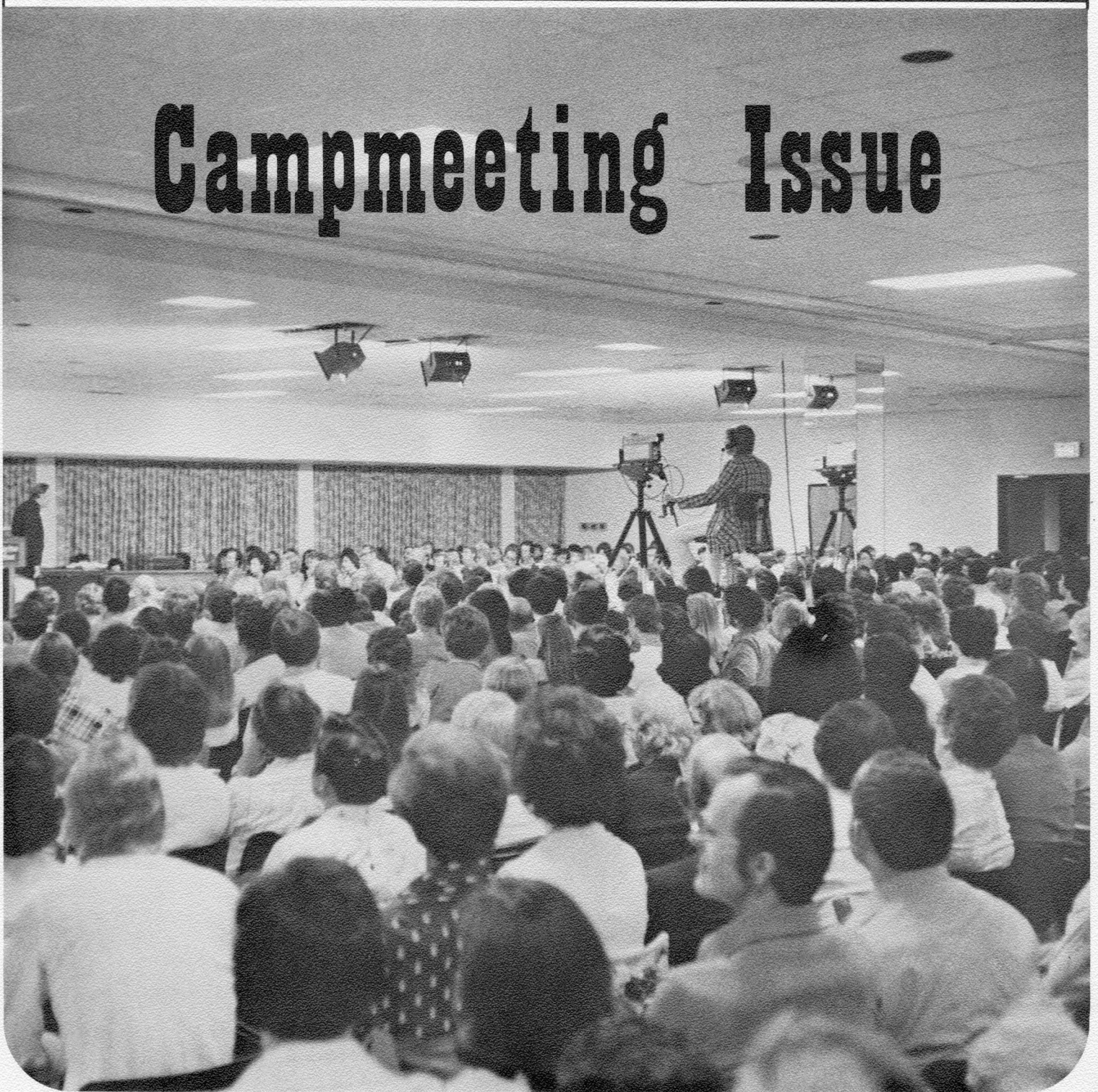

THE GLORY OF GOD!

BY KENNETH E. HAGIN

ACTS 7:55

55 But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,

There is a statement--almost in the center of this verse--which is of utmost importance. Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost, did great wonders and miracles among the people. (Acts 6:5,8.) Yet certain Jews gnashed their teeth upon him and stoned him to death. He became the first martyr. Here, at his death, he looked up stedfastly into heaven and saw something. What did he see? He saw the 'glory of God.'

Did you ever see the glory of God? I've seen it just as Stephen did. I will relate it. But first go with me through many scriptures--scriptural facts--so you can get a clear picture. Then I'll give some personal experiences. And then I'll give you some things the Lord has said to me which are going to start happening in the year 1975.

We'll begin in Exodus with Moses talking to the children of Israel:

EXODUS 16:7, 10

7 And in the morning, then ye shall see the glory of the LORD; for that he heareth your murmurings against the LORD: and what are we, that ye murmur against us?...

10 And it came to pass, (this is the next morning now) as Aaron spake unto the whole congregation of the children of Israel, that they looked toward the wilderness, and, behold, the glory of the LORD appeared in the cloud.

EXODUS 40:34-35

34 Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

35 And Moses was not able to enter into the tent of the congregation, because the cloud abode thereon, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

See also Exodus 29:43; Leviticus 9:4,6,23; Numbers 14:10; 16:19,42; 20:6.

I KINGS 8:10-11

10 And it came to pass, when the priests were come out of the holy place, that the cloud filled the house of the LORD, 11 So that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of the LORD.

II CHRONICLES 5:11-14

11 And it came to pass, when the priests were come out of the holy place...

12 Also the Levites which were the singers...with their sons and their brethren being arrayed in white linen, having cymbals and psalteries and harps, stood at the east end of the altar, and with them an hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets:)

13 It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the LORD;

14 So that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God.

II CHRONICLES 7:1-2

1 Now when Solomon had made an end of praying, the fire came down from heaven, and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices; and the glory of the LORD filled the house.

2 And the priests could not enter into the house of the LORD, because the glory of the LORD had filled the LORD's house.

Describing his vision of the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, Isaiah says, "And the posts of the door moved at the voice of him that cried, and the house was filled with smoke" (Isaiah 6:4). Hold that in remembrance as we read from Isaiah's prophecies about the flourishing of Christ's kingdom, the church. And then about

the glorious access of the Gentiles into that church:

ISAIAH 35:1-2

1 The wilderness and the solitary place shall be glad for them; and the desert shall rejoice, and blossom as the rose.

2 It shall blossom abundantly, and rejoice even with joy and singing: the glory of Lebanon shall be given unto it, the excellency of Carmel and Sharon, they shall see the glory of the LORD, and the excellency of our God.

ISAIAH 58:8

8 Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy rereward.

ISAIAH 59:19

19 So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.

Now we're seeing what the glory of the Lord is--it's the Spirit of the Lord!

ISAIAH 60:1-3

1 Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.

2 For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.

3 And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising.

Ezekiel saw the glory of God.

EZEKIEL 3:23

23 Then I arose, and went forth into the plain: and, behold, the glory of the LORD

stood there, as the glory which I saw by the river of Chebar: and I fell on my face,

He likened the glory of the LORD which stood there on the plain to the glory he saw by the river Chebar. Let's go back to the 1st chapter where he describes that:

EZEKIEL 1:28

28 As the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain, so was the appearance of the brightness round about. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD. And when I saw it, I fell upon my face, and I heard a voice of one that spake.

EZEKIEL 8:4

4 And, behold, the glory of the God of Israel was there, according to the vision that I saw in the plain.

EZEKIEL 10:4

4 Then the glory of the LORD went up from the cherub, and stood over the threshold of the house; and the house was filled with the cloud, and the court was full of the brightness of the LORD's glory.

EZEKIEL 43:2, 4, 5

2 And, behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east: and his voice was like a noise of many waters: and the earth shined with his glory...

4 And the glory of the LORD came into the house by the way of the gate whose prospect is toward the east.

5 So the spirit took me up, and brought me into the inner court; and, behold, the glory of the LORD filled the house.

EZEKIEL 44:4

4 Then brought he me the way of the north gate before the house: and I looked, and, behold, the glory of the LORD filled the house of the LORD: and I fell upon my face.

That's not nearly all of these scriptures in the Old Testament. But it's enough to establish something. Now let's see if there is anything about it in the New Testament.

MATTHEW 17:1-6

1 And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into a high mountain apart,

2 And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.

3 And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elias talking with him.

4 Then answered Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here:

if thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.

5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.

6 And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their face, and were sore afraid.

In Luke's account we see that the disciples entered into the cloud. (Luke 9:34.)

Since childhood most of us have known the following verses. But there's something in it we've missed.

LUKE 2:8-9

8 And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night.

9 And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.

The glory shone! They could see it!

Let's look again at Stephen with a little more understanding now. He is preaching here to the Jews in Jerusalem:

ACTS 7:2

2 And he (Stephen) said, Men, brethren, and fathers, hearken; The God of glory (Did you know God is a God of glory!) appeared unto our father Abraham, when he was in Mesopotamia, before he dwelt in Charran,

Then, when they stoned Stephen he looked up into heaven and saw the glory of God.

ACTS 9:1-4

1 And Saul, yet breathing out threatenings and slaughter against the disciples of the Lord, went unto the high priest, 2 And desired of him letters to Damascus to the synagogues, that if he found any of this way, whether they were men or women, he might bring them bound unto Jerusalem.

3 And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven:

4 And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?

Notice how Paul described it

when he related this experience on two later occasions:

ACTS 22:6, 11

6 And it came to pass, that, as I made my journey, and was come nigh unto Damascus about noon, suddenly there shone from heaven a great light round about me...

11 And when I could not see for the glory of that light, being led by the hand of them that were with me, I came into Damascus.

ACTS 26:13-14

13 At midday, O king, I saw in the way a light from heaven, above the brightness of the sun, shining round about me and them which journeyed with me.

14 And when we were all fallen to the earth...

--THE SPIRIT OF THE LORD--

ROMANS 6:4

4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Jesus was raised up from the dead by the 'glory of the Father.' What is the glory of the Father? Romans 8:11 tells us.

ROMANS 8:11

11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

REVELATION 15:8

8 And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple...

REVELATION 21:23

23 And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.

My first experience along this line happened the 16th day of August, 1933, in the north bedroom of 405 North College St. in the city of McKinney, Texas. I didn't know what it was then.

Sick and afflicted all my life I had become bedfast in April, 1933, at the age of 16. Doctors said I would die--and could die at any moment. So someone

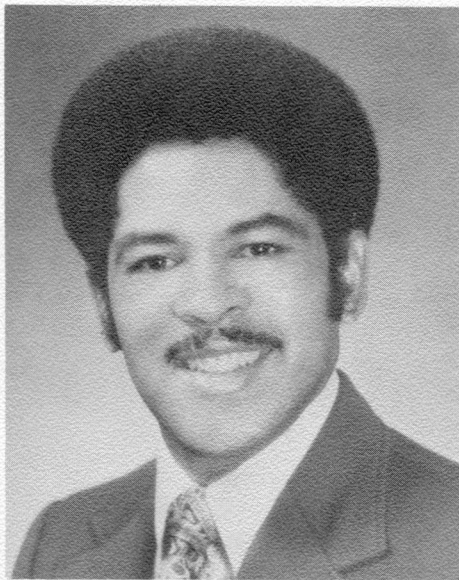

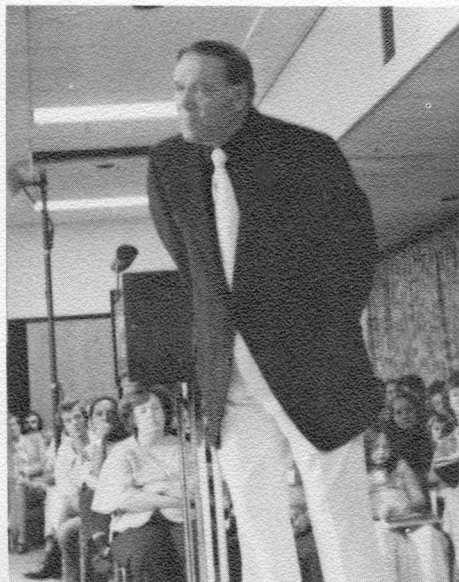

stayed at my bedside all that day.

The official temperature that August day was 106 degrees. But I was as cold as ice. They placed hot water bottles and heated bricks around me, and covered me with blankets, but still I was cold as ice. A death dew was upon my brow. I knew all morning I was dying.

Only one person was allowed in the room at a time. At 1:30 in the afternoon it was my 9 year old brother, Pat, who was with me when death fastened its final throes upon me. I felt myself slipping out of the flesh to cross over to the other side.

"Pat, get Mama quick," I said. "I want to tell her good-bye."

The last thing I saw in the natural was Pat running out of the room.

Then the whole room lit up! Brighter than the noontday sun glistening on the snow!

(Did you notice how the scriptures used words in connection with the glory of god such as: cloud, bright, brightness, light, shone, smoke?)

I ascended and went up into that glory. A few minutes before I fought with all the fiber I had naturally to hang on--to keep from going. But as soon as death came and I went up into that glory--I didn't want to come back! There was a peace...a tranquillity. An indescribable something which defies the human language to describe!

I got up about where the top of the house should be. Then my ascent stopped. I was in that glory. I looked back down into the room. It was lit up with that glory. I saw my body on the bed--mouth open, eyes set in death. Then I looked into that glory as I heard a voice, a male voice, saying, "Go back. Go back. Go back. You can't come yet. Your work on earth is not done."

Then I descended, and slipped back down inside my body like a man would slip his foot inside his boot.

When I did, I realized Mama was stooped over me, holding my hand in hers.

"Mama, I'm not going to die now," I told her.

She thought I meant I wasn't going to die 'now' this minute. But I meant I'm not going to die now--I'm going to live and do the work of God.

For nearly 30 years I never spoke of this. It was too sacred. But in recent years, because the Lord told me to, I've spoken of some of these things. In teaching on the radio about the inward man and how the inner man is an eternal spirit being who never dies, I recited this incident.

My mother heard the broadcast over the Dallas station. I had never talked to her about it.

In visiting with her shortly thereafter she said to me, "Son, there's a side to that you don't know." And she told me her side of it.

"Pat came running into the kitchen crying, 'Mama, Granny, come quick. Ken's dying.' We rushed out of the kitchen, up the hall, through the dining room and to your bedroom. But we couldn't get inside.

"The door to your room was wide open, but we couldn't get in. The room was filled with something. We couldn't see into it. I ran up to the doorway and bounced off something like you'd bounce off a rubber ball.

(Remember how the scriptures said the priests couldn't get in?)

"I sensed a Presence in that room and backed back into the dining room.

"Granny came running behind me. She ran into it and bounced back. Determined to get in to see about you, she backed half way across the dining room and took a running start--but when she hit it she bounced back. Again she tried--and failed. So she clung to the door facing, while I stood back, and we waited.

"The way you told it on the radio you thought it was only a

few seconds. But we waited ten minutes before it began to lift and we could get into the room."

To me that was so sacred. I have no fear of death. I've been out there. If you never see that glory in this life, when physical death comes, if you're a Christian, you step into it. David spoke about God blessing him in this life--and afterward receiving him into glory! (Psalm 73:24.)

Space doesn't permit me to relate here many experiences we've had along this line through more than 40 years of ministry. We do go into them in the tape on this subject. As well as some manifestations of the power of God throughout church history.

Someone may ask, "What is the purpose of all this?" Let me take you to a familiar scripture and show you something you may not have seen. We are so familiar with Peter's quotation of Joel's prophecy on the day of Pentecost. "And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh..." But notice that he went on to say this:

ACTS 2:19

19 And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke:

Some take that out of its setting and interpret it to mean bombs falling and people being killed. But that wouldn't be something God would do. God is not a murderer. Jesus came as God manifested in the flesh and He said, "The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life..." (John 10:10).

God said these are things He is going to do--signs put in this earth concerning His Presence. Blood. The blood of Jesus! Fire. The Holy Ghost is Fire! Tongues of fire appeared and sat upon each of them.

Recently in our part of the country folks called out the fire department when it seemed the roof of a church was on fire. The town saw it. Sinners saw it. But when the firemen arrived there was no fire to put out!

God said I will do signs in the earth. Bombs falling? People being killed? No! Manifestations of the power of God.

God dealt with Israel as He did because they were spiritually dead. He had to appeal to

them by way of their physical senses. So the glory of the Lord came down as we have read--and they could see it with their eyes.

God said to me in recent times that such manifestations will come into prominence in these last days. To reach those who are spiritually dead He has to go through their physical senses. There will be signs in the earth beneath--which come about because of the outpouring

of the Spirit of God. God is going to display His glory!

When is all this going to start to happen? We're on the verge of it right now. And we're going to step over into it in the Fall of this year.

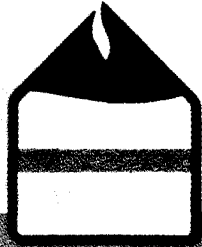
